KANKAKEE VALLEY SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA

"WE WILL BE BACK!" was a sentence in the closing paragraph of the 2019-2020 KVSO Season Report. And here we are...



Our last in-person full concert was February 29, 2020. While the months since then have been a challenge for everyone, the Pandemic provided KVSO with many opportunities to keep our name in the public arena and to keep some of our excellent musicians playing.

With the support of a creative Board of Directors, we sponsored a series of "Music in the Parks" in Kankakee and Manteno, featuring quartet and quintet performances and a Halloween performance at the Kankakee Farmers' Market. When the weather turned cold, KVSO quartets and quintets performed at two local churches - Asbury United Methodist and Maternity BVM. Our Board voted to offer each of these events at no charge to the community.

The KVSO's traditional Fourth of July event for 2020 was cancelled. However, the Kankakee County Board and the Kankakee Valley Park District cosponsored a magnificent Fourth of July celebration with fireworks and much more. KVSO is grateful that the County Board and the Park District contributed the excess fundraising dollars to KVSO.

On another positive note, KVSO, Kankakee Valley Park District and Kankakee Community College have partnered to bring back the traditional Fourth of July celebration on Sunday, July 4, 2021 on the KCC grounds!

KVSO GUILD

At the May, 2020, Zoom meeting, Kankakee Valley Symphony Orchestra Women's Guild ladies approved a new leadership team who enthusiastically set forth to carry on the successes of the Guild, following the leadership of our esteemed prior chairman Jane Veers. Unfortunately, Covid challenges caused us to continue to have to meet by Zoom until spring 2021 and to cancel planned in-person fundraisers (the fashion show, Octoberfest, Symphony of Sweets). But, with the creative efforts of Val Schuller, Dee Pinski, and Iane Veers, a December No-Show Dinner netted proceeds of \$4600.

Due to the death of long-time member Rose Mary Ciaccio and the untimely passing of various members' loved ones, we established a memorial fund to donate \$100 to the Orchestra in memory of each of these relatives. We voted to make this an ongoing fund. Additional donations are voluntary and participation has been encouraging.

Our in-person meeting in March 2021 was a joyous reunion as we reconvened for the first time in many months, to conduct event-planning and to reunite as friends who have missed the comraderie among our members that enables us to plan and host the lovely events which have been the hallmark of the Guild's efforts over the years. As an auxiliary to the KVSO, our ladies anticipate assisting, as needed, with the proposed July 4th concert.

In addition, we are looking forward to a September 23rd fashion show, chaired by Dee Pinski and Donna Karlock (after several cancelled attempts to host this event) and a renewal of the Symphony of Sweets on December 5th at the Kankakee Country Club.

At our April meeting, the nominating committee presented names to be voted on as the Guild leadership team for the coming year. All those who served this past year were asked to continue in the same capacity. Additionally, a co-chair position was added. The leadership team to be approved consists of the following: Chairman, Vicky McBurnie; Cochairman, Karen Korup-Duchene; Notetaker, Carol Vallone; Bookkeeper, Jane Veers. These positions were accepted by acclamation at the May spring banquet and duly installed to lead for 2021-2022.

Finally, we eagerly voted to gratefully donate \$7000 to the Kankakee Valley Symphony Orchestra, our proceeds from this year's fund-raising and contributions. It was an honor and a privilege to humbly present this check to our conductor at the spring banquet.

2021 ANNUAL REPORT OF THE

FOUNDATION

Due to the generosity of benefactors over the years, the Foundation funds started the year with \$581,675, as of May 2020. Each year, an amount is transferred to the operating fund of the Symphony, based on a formula designed to support annual operating budget while maintaining the long term viability of the invested funds. Based on that formula, a total of \$19.047 was transferred from the investments to the operating funds of the Kankakee Valley Symphony Orchestra during the 2020-2021 season. After ten months of growth and the transfer to operations, the invested funds have grown to \$733,100 at the end of March 2021.

Annual gifts of any size help to support the programs that we have enjoyed in our local community. We ask that you consider larger gifts, either during your life time or in your estate plan, that can assure that future generations have the opportunity to enjoy the quality of performances that we have been able to provide.

Because of the foresight of those who have gone before us, we have been able to help sustain the Symphony during this difficult year. We hope to gather again soon to enjoy quality entertainment. Thank you to all of our donors.
